Filmmaking twin brothers Danny and Michael Philippou's debut feature film *Talk To Me* took the world by storm,

making its international premiere at Sundance Film Festival 2023 and screening at Berlinale, SXSW and Adelaide Film Festival.

The film was acquired by A24 and has since become their highest-grossing horror film and second highest-grossing film overall,

bringing in over \$92 million USD in the box office worldwide. *Talk To Me* has won countless awards including AACTA Awards for Best Film, Best Direction and Best Screenplay and a Saturn Award for Best Horror Film.

The pair made their start as
RackaRacka, online purveyors
of comic horror and action.
Their Youtube videos have been
watched over 1.5 billion times and
have amassed over 6.6 million
subscribers. Named one of Variety's
2016 Fame Changers and ranked

fifth on Financial Review's Cultural Power List, the brothers have won numerous awards for their online work, including Best Overall at the Online Video Awards and the AACTA Award for the Best Web Show.



His shorts have screened at festivals around the world, including the Short Film Métrage at Cannes, Giffoni

(Italy), Flickerfest (Sydney), Byron Bay and the San Francisco International Film Festival. In 2021 he was an episode director on Netflix series Gymnastics Academy: A Second Chance. In 2022 his documentary The Rover of Tobruk was acquired by Fox Sports (USA). His feature documentary, The Burnt Half tells the story of communities on South Australia's Kangaroo Island affected by the Black Summer bushfires, and was acquired by SBS for broadcast, with X4 handling international sales.

His feature film, The Run, a postapocalyptic action thriller, is slated for production in 2024, with Global Film signed on to handle international sales.
